MYOCARDIAL PERFUSION SCAN

WHAT IS A SESTAMIBI (MIBI) CARDIAC SCAN?

This test determines whether blood flow to your heart muscle is normal or reduced. Usually performed for suspected angina, or known heart disease.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN DURING THE TEST?

There are two parts to the MIBI scan, called Rest and Stress parts.

The Rest stage involves an injection of radioactive tracer (MIBI) into a vein of the arm, waiting 30-45 minutes, then having pictures taken of your heart by a large camera. This takes approximately 30 minutes.

The Stress stage involves either exercise on a treadmill, or, if unable to exercise, a medication injected via a cannula in an arm vein, which increases blood flow to the heart. After a 30-45 minute wait the same images will be performed again so a direct comparison can be made of your heart at Stress and Rest. Total time of test is approximately 2.5 hours.

IS ANY PREPARATION NEEDED?

NO TEA, COFFEE or CHOCOLATE for 24 hours prior to your appointment.

Avoid the following for 72 hours prior to testing – Viagra, Cialis, Levitra.

You may be asked to stop some of your blood pressure or heart medications unless your doctor asks you to keep taking them.

WHAT TO DO ON THE MORNING OF THE TEST?

Light breakfast only, two hours prior to your appointment. Diabetic patients please bring your blood sugar monitoring equipment. If on insulin, have a light breakfast and half your normal insulin dose. If not on insulin, have a light breakfast and omit your oral anti-diabetic medication eg Diabex, Diamicron.

PREGNANCY WARNING:

If there is a chance that you could be pregnant, or if you are breast feeding, please notify staff BEFORE proceeding with the first injection.

CT CORONARY ANGIOGRAM (CTCA)

WHAT IS A CT CORONARY ANGIOGRAM (CTCA)?

This test determines if there is any calcium build up or blockages in the coronary arteries that may cause heart problems in the future.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN DURING THE TEST?

There are two parts to the test.

You will initially see a nurse and a doctor who will check your history and perform basic observations. You may need to be given a beta blocker medication to slow the heart rate.

Once the medication has had time to take effect (approximately 1 hour) you will have a cannula put into a vein in your arm. A CT contrast will be injected into this needle in your arm and pictures will be taken for approximately 15 minutes.

IS ANY PREPARATION NEEDED?

NO TEA, COFFEE or CHOCOLATE for 12 hours prior to your appointment. (Please note this needs to be increased to 24 hours if having a Myocardial Perfusion scan).

Avoid the following for 72 hours prior to testing – Viagra, Cialis, Levitra.

WHAT TO DO ON THE MORNING OF THE TEST

Fast 2 hours prior to the test.

You may drink water.


