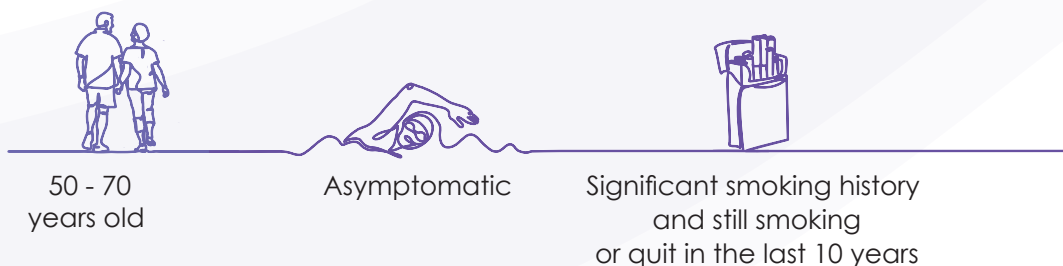


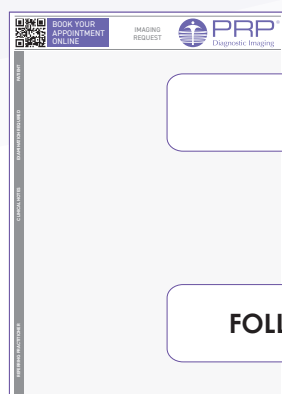

INITIAL SCAN

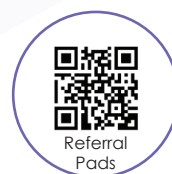
National Lung Cancer Screening Program (NLCSP)

Patient is eligible for the National Lung Cancer Screening Program

FOLLOW UP SCAN

National Lung Cancer Screening Program (NLCSP) Interval Scan

Follow-up per report dated e.g. 17/08/2025



PATHWAY



Patient referred to PRP has low dose CT



Report returned within 3 days



Automatic patient recall when next screening CT is due, improving longterm participation and reduce practice administration.

ADDITIONAL FINDINGS

Patients requiring further assessment are managed through established clinical pathways with referrers notified of significant findings. Additional findings may include:



EMPHYSEMA /COPD



CORONARY ARTERY CALCIFICATION



INTERSTITIAL LUNG ABNORMALITIES



THYROID NODULES



ADRENAL, RENAL OR LIVER MASSES

WHEN DOES MY PATIENT RETURN FOR SCANNING?

NLCSP Nodule Management Protocol (NMP)

**NEGATIVE
VERY LOW RISK**

**Return for screening
24 months**

**BENIGN APPEARANCE
LOW RISK**

**Return for screening
12 months**

LOW TO MODERATE

**Return for screening
6 months**

**SUSPICIOUS
MODERATE RISK**

**Return for screening
3 months**

**VERY SUSPICIOUS,
URGENT REVIEW
HIGH/VERY HIGH RISK**

**Refer to respiratory
physician**
